## "ROBOBOTS"

This year, a team of Perry High School students is partnering with the Perry Nuclear Plant Employee Association to design and build a robot to compete with other area schools at AWT (Alliance for Working Together) RoboBots. AWT Robobots is a regional competition affiliated with the National Robotics League (NRL) which promotes and encourages the exploration of careers in manufacturing.
