

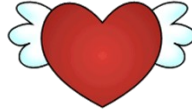

A Message From Mrs. Poremba

Winter and early spring is the time of year we start thinking about Kindergarten Registration for the upcoming 2012-2013 school year. Children who will be age (5) by September 30, 2012, will be eligible to enter Kindergarten in the fall. We have created an online Kindergarten pre-registration link so that we can gather important information on incoming Kindergarten students. The advantage to completing the online information is, this will allow us to have your forms completed and ready for your signature at the time of registration. The families who complete the pre-registration will still be required to attend Kindergarten Registration, which is scheduled the mornings of Monday, March 26th through Wednesday, March 28th, to submit the proper supporting documentation and sign their completed registration forms. Hard copies of the registration forms will be available online and sent home with children who attend Perry Pre-School, YMCA Daycare, Luv-Learn-N-Laughter, and St. Paul's Pre-School. Registration Packets will also be available at the Board of Education and Perry Elementary School closer to the registration date. **You will not be required to fill out hard copies of the registration form if you complete this online form.** You will be required to complete the Ohio Health History Information.

The online pre-registration form should only take 10-15 minutes to complete if you gather the following information prior to starting: parents work and cell phone numbers, parents e-mail address, pre-school address and phone number, names and phone numbers for child's physician, dentist, medical specialist, local hospital, and up to two (2) emergency contacts name address and daytime phone number.

We are looking forward to starting the process to get to know our incoming Kindergarten students. All Perry Primary families with incoming Kindergarteners are encouraged to use the online pre-registration to simplify the overall process and form completion. Please share this information with your friends and neighbors that have students who will be starting Kindergarten next year.
